 The Obligation of **Abstinence** (not eating meat) begins at age 14.
 The Obligation of **Fasting** begins with the 18th birthday and ends with the 60th birthday.



"Fasting" in Lent means only one full meal that day with two smaller meals which together do not equal a full meal---all without meat.
