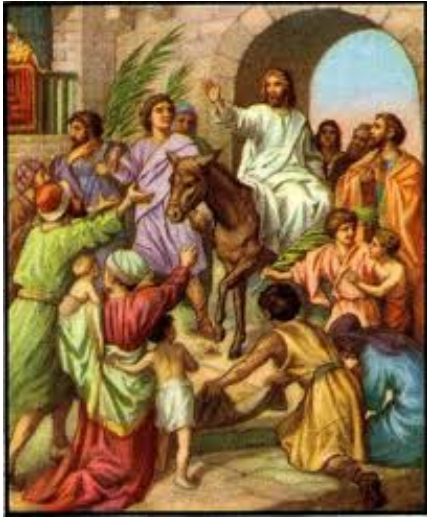

**Tuesday of Holy Week: Angelus** 7:00 PM Mass, of the Lord's Supper (Holy Thursday); Confessions follow.

**Wednesday of Holy Week:** 7:00 AM Mass

**Holy Thursday**, St. Joseph: After 7:00 PM Mass and Reposition of the Blessed Sacrament, you are invited to spend some time in silent prayer with your family in memory of the Lord's request of His Apostles, "*Can you not stay awake and watch one hour with me?*" **Adoration until 10:00 PM.**

**Good Friday.** There is no Mass on Good Friday. The Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death at St. Joseph beginning at 1:00 PM followed by Confessions. **At Angelus**, Services at 3:00 PM followed by Confessions

**Holy Saturday.** 7:30 PM. Mass will begin with the Blessing of Fire and the Paschal Candle, include the Blessing of Easter Water and Renewal of Baptismal Promises. You are encouraged to take Blessed Easter Water home with you for your prayerful use. (NO Holy Saturday Service at Angelus) We will celebrate the Professions of Faith of Olivia Sampson, James West and Casey Zerr and the Baptisms of third grader Cecilio Gaucin and infant Robert Dionne, Jr.

**Easter Sunday.** Masses at 8:00 AM, Angelus and 10:00 AM, St. Joseph, with Blessing of Easter Water, Renewal of Baptismal Promises.

(Blessing of Easter Food at Saturday & Sunday Masses)

**Special Collections for this Season**

1. The special collection for the Catholic Relief Services, the **American Bishops' Overseas Appeal**. Special envelopes are in your packets. **(Please make checks to your PARISH---NOT to any of the collections!)**
