Lent, 2019

This year the penitential season of Lent begins this week on Ash Wednesday, March 6. A Lenten calendar of events for March and April is available in our churches to assist you in planning your participation in this Holy Season.

A Lenten Schedule is also posted on our website under "Bulletin" at sj oakley.org .

While Ash Wednesday is NOT a Holy Day of Obligation, it is a day of **FAST** and **ABSTINENCE**.

The Obligation of **Abstinence** (not eating meat) begins at age 14.

The Obligation of **Fasting** begins with the 18th birthday and ends with the 60th birthday.

"**Fasting**" in Lent means only one full meal that day with two smaller meals which together do not equal a full meal---all without meat.
