Mission Cooperative

This year our parishioners are called to share our blessings with the **Diocese of Gallup, New Mexico**. The Diocese of Gallup is a multicultural, expansive mission diocese, comprising 55,000 square miles in Northeastern Arizona and Northwestern New Mexico with seven different Native American reservations and pueblos. The landscape, people, and faith expression within this area are extraordinary and unlike any other diocese in the United States and, perhaps, the world. There are 53 parishes, 13 schools, and 5 social centers within the diocesan boundaries—all serving approximately 63,000 Catholics making it one of the nation's largest (in area) and poorest. While we ourselves are a Mission Diocese, we enjoy many Godly blessings to share with our less fortunate brothers and sisters.
