From the Pastor

This weekend begins the new initiative of the Eucharistic Revival. The mission of this revival is “to renew the Church by enkindling a living relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.” As the Catechism of the Catholic Church states in paragraph 1324, “the Eucharist ‘is the source and summit of the Christian life.’” Without belief in the True Presence in the Eucharist, our Catholic life suffers. With this central profession of the faith, only 30% of Catholics believe in the True Presence. To build a community of faith of any kind, one must build the foundation first. Besides the Trinity, what teaching could be any more foundational in the Catholic life?

Lake Masses: A few weeks ago, I wrote about the new protocols for lake masses in the Diocese of Salina. We received an update on these protocols from Bishop Vincke. “At the College of Consulters meeting...we had a long discussion on Masses at lakes during the summer. After priests spoke of the pros and cons, they left the decision to me. I prayed about it and called several bishops to get their opinion. The bishops I spoke with all supported Masses at the lake. One bishop told me that he lives in a diocese in which tourists come to fish during parts of the year and they offer Masses for them outdoors. So, we will continue with Masses at the lake during the summer months. However, our policy of not celebrating wedding Masses outdoors remains the same. I realize that might seem contradictory to some, but the other dioceses that I talked to have the same policy.”

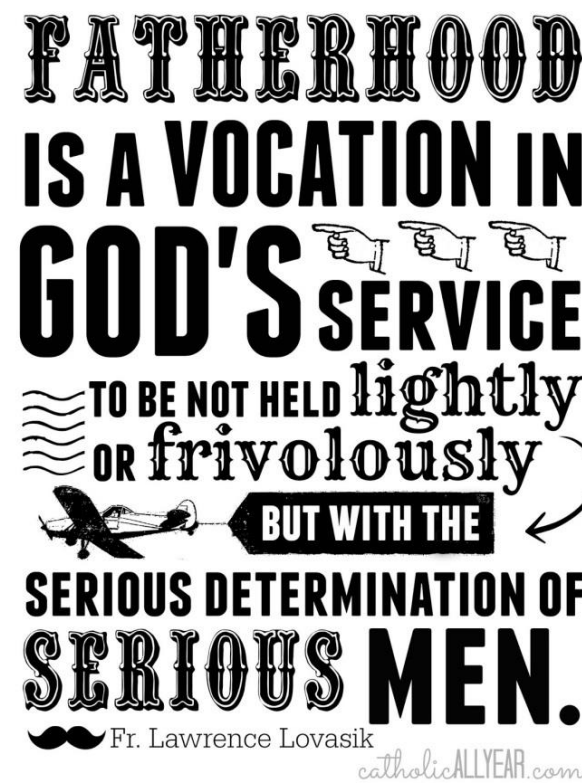
