St. Joseph Bible Study: Seven Deadly Sins Seven Lively Virtues this summer at 10:00 on Tuesday mornings in the church basement. During video talks, Bishop Robert Barron looks at what Catholic tradition calls the Seven Deadly sins and contrasts them with what he refers to as the Seven Lively virtues. We will also watch *Purgatorio* from Dante’s masterpiece, *The Divine Comedy*, where each of these deadly sins - Pride, Envy, Anger, Sloth, Avarice, Gluttony, Lust—is punished. Bishop Barron sees the countervailing actions for each sin in *Purgatorio* as the Seven Lively Virtues - Humility, Admiration, Forgiveness, Zeal, Generosity, Asceticism, Chastity – an antidote meant to be practiced in order to turn from that particular sinful pattern.
