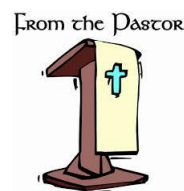

From the Pastor This past Friday was the feast of the Sacred Heart. This is an excerpt from a work by St. Bonaventure: Take thought now, redeemed man, and consider how great and worthy is he who hangs on the cross for you. His death brings the dead to life, but at his passing heaven and earth are plunged into mourning, and hard rocks are split asunder. It was a divine decree that permitted one of the soldiers to open his sacred side with a lance. This was done so that the Church might be formed from the side of Christ as he slept the sleep of death on the cross, and so that the Scripture might be fulfilled: 'They shall look on him whom they pierced'. The blood and water which poured out at that moment were the price of our salvation. Flowing from the secret abyss of our Lord's heart as from a fountain, this stream gave the sacraments of the Church the power to confer the life of grace, while for those already living in Christ it became a spring of living water welling up to life everlasting.

Thank you to all who helped with the Totus Tuus program this past week. It would not be possible without the volunteers to help during the day, families providing meals and snacks, the kids who attend the program, and those who prayed for the success of the program during the week. The first week of this program is always the most stressful for the team as they try and find their groove with their team and with the program itself. As the busy summer is underway here are a couple of things to keep in mind: 1) If you are traveling and will not have access to a Sunday Mass, please come talk to me. Per the Code of Canon Law, pastors have the authority to dispense their parishioners from the Sunday obligation for a legitimate reason, e.g. going on a cruise. This is on a case-by-case basis, and must be given before the trip and not after. If a dispensation is not obtained, it is still a mortal sin to not fulfill the Sunday obligation. 2) St. Joseph offers an online giving option for donations to the church if you are away for multiple weekends. It is easy to set up and can do through the parish website, sjoakley.org. Have a safe and wonderful summer!
