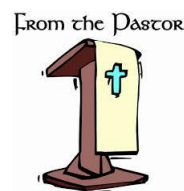

From the Pastor 2<sup>nd</sup> Installment of St. Cyprian's Treatise on the Lord's Prayer - We go on to say, *May your name be hallowed*. It is not that we think to make God holy by our prayers; rather we are asking God that his name may be made holy in us. Indeed, how could God be made holy, he who is the source of holiness? Still, because he himself said: *Be holy, for I am holy*, we pray and beseech him that we who have been hallowed in baptism may persevere in what we have begun. And we pray for this every day, for we have need of daily sanctification; sinning every day, we cleanse our faults again and again by constant sanctification. The apostle Paul instructs us in these words concerning the sanctification which God's loving kindness confers on us: *Neither the immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor robbers will inherit the kingdom of God. And such indeed you were. But you have been washed, you have been sanctified, you have been justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.* We were sanctified, he says, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God. Hence we make our prayer that this sanctification may remain in us. But further, our Lord who is also our judge warns those who have been cured and brought back to life by him to sin no more lest something worse happen to them. Thus we offer constant prayers and beg night and day that this sanctification and new life which is ours by God's favor may be preserved by his protection.

**Movie** - You may have heard about the movie *Sound of Freedom*. It is a true story regarding the horrors of human trafficking. The main character is played by Jim Caviezel, who played Jesus in *The Passion of the Christ*, and the production company, Angel Studios, produces the series, *The Chosen*. Human Trafficking, especially of children, is the fastest growing criminal activity in the world. It has passed Arms Trafficking and will soon bypass even the Drug Trade. The first step is making people aware of this horrible tragedy. It could be one of the children in our parish. "God's children are not for sale!" It is being released July 4<sup>th</sup> in select theatres. The closest theatre at this time showing the movie is in Salina. But be on the lookout for it in the future.

As mentioned several times in the past, we are moving on to working on the school building. To do this effectively, a building committee needs to be assembled.
