From the Pastor

Missionary Appeal On the weekend of July 13/14, 2024, Fr. Henry Saw Lone will give a mission appeal at our parish. Fr. Henry Saw Lone is a missionary priest assigned by the Salina Diocese in our respective parishes for the 2024 Missionary Cooperative Plan.

Myanmar today is in yet another chapter of darkness, bloodshed, and repression. Myanmar's military Army chief, Min Aung Hlaing, seized power in the country in a coup on February 1, 2021, abruptly halting the country's democratic transition and detaining the country's leader, Aung San Suu Kyi, and the democratically-elected leaders while making up charges to hold them.

The goal of his Mission appeal is aimed at financing pastoral activities to provide relief for refugees, pastoral activities such as giving the sacraments and teaching catechism in remote areas, building clinics, schools and providing clean water, food, and medical care in rural areas in Taungngu Diocese, Myanmar. Your generosity makes it possible for these missionaries to bring Christ to the poor.

The second collection will be taken to support Missionary activities in Myanmar. Your kind welcome and generous support is most appreciated.

Supernatural gifts can be seen from the outside as something awe-inspiring and something to be marveled at. However, many of the saints who have had incredible gifts given to them were very reluctant to put forward that they had these gifts. Our second reading is believed, by some, to be the first instance of the stigmata, which is where one experiences the visual and physical pains of the wounds of Christ. Other gifts include mysticism (visions of hell, purgatory or heaven), levitation, reading souls (knowing the sin or virtue of a soul), healings, tongues (needs a translator for it to be authentic), etc. While many may wonder, "Why not me?", I would argue that the vast majority would not be able to handle the spiritual weight of these supernatural gifts. These signs are given not just because God feels like it, but because this person is to bring about the conversion of sinners in a unique way. Ordinary gifts are still gifts, and they too are to be used for the conversion of sinners. Let one not be fooled into thinking that because one does not have extraordinary spiritual gifts, one is still called to holiness, nonetheless. Also, let pray for those with these extraordinary spiritual gifts that they will be able to bear the burdens that come with them.
